The Asian Occupational Safety and health Research Institute (AOSHRI) Progress Meeting was held from 27 to 28 August 2019 at the National Institute Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) Malaysia located at Bangi, Selangor, Malaysia. The agenda of the meeting are as follows:

- To** discuss on current progress of Occupational Safety and health (OSH) collaboration research and ongoing projects,
- To** utilise information shared by each country to identify new and emerging OSH issues,
- To** consolidate the emerging OSH issues through new collaboration projects among country members,
- To** share OSH practices in Malaysia with AOSHRI members, and
- To** facilitate a greater exchange of ideas and to advance OSH knowledge and innovation.

## AOSHRI PROGRESS MEETING 2019



### International Platform to Strengthen the OSH Research Collaboration

The AOSHRI Progress Meeting 2019 was decided last year (2018) during the 7<sup>th</sup> AOSHRI Meeting in Taiwan. The meeting had decided that NIOSH Malaysia should organise the AOSHRI Progress Meeting in order to ensure the collaborative research among AOSHRI's country members is on schedule and achieved its objectives.

NIOSH Consultation, Research and Development Department (CRDD) as the anchor of the event, together with assistance of other departments was given the responsibility to organise the progress meeting. The AOSHRI progress meeting 2019 was organised back to back with Malaysia's biggest OSH conference and exhibition known as COSH 2019 on 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> August 2019. Six of the AOSHRI country members also participated as plenary and concurrent speakers Japan and Republic of Korea participated as plenary speakers, while Singapore, Taiwan, Sri Lanka and Thailand were involved as concurrent speakers. A very positive feedback was received from more than 1,000 participants in response to the paper presentation by AOSHRI member at COSH 2019.

A total of 18 delegates have attended the programme with Malaysia, Japan, Singapore, Thailand, Sri Lanka and Brunei had sent a representative each while Taiwan and Republic of Korea sent 3 participants each and another 6 were from Indonesia. Cambodian representative couldn't make it at the last minute due to unforeseen circumstances in his country. NIOSH Malaysia was represented by Mr. Hj. Mohd. Esa Bin Hj. Baruji, Technical Expert 1 (Principle Researcher) for CRDD.

There were four collaborative research projects discussed in the 4 smaller groups consist of the delegates, NIOSH technical expert, rapporteur and moderator to discuss the objectives, scope, methodology, data collection strategy and other related matters pertaining to the particular projects. Three collaborative projects were actually the continuation projects from last AOSHRI meeting in Taiwan (Construction Safety, Psychosocial Health, and Under Reporting). Meanwhile, one of the new proposed collaborative projects was Industrial Revolution 4.0 (IR 4.0). The meeting had agreed to formalise the appointment of a leader and deputy leader for each project to coordinate and monitor the progress of the project. NIOSH Malaysia was elected as the deputy leader for the IR 4.0 and under-reporting projects.



The delegates were also brought to visit the Royal Museum in Kuala Lumpur, Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre (KLCC), PETRONAS Twin Towers and Occupational Safety & Health Evaluation and Control Technology Centre (OSHECT) NIOSH Malaysia. They were later treated to local cuisines at De' Wan 1958 Café where they also sampled famous local fruits such as durian, cempedak, mangosteen, langsat and rambutan.

Korea Occupational Safety and Health Agency (KOSHA) representative also made a presentation on KOSHA's background, IOHA 2020 programme and the proposed AOSHRI 2020. The decision to appoint KOSHA as the next chairman was made during AOSHRI 2018 in Taiwan. NIOSH Malaysia was grateful with the attendance and participation of AOSHRIs' delegates.

The secretariat of the AOSHRI progress meeting also would like to thank NIOSH Malaysia's top management, especially our Executive Director, Mr. Hj. Ayop Bin Salleh, in making this programme a success through strong financial and moral support. Not to forget, our Executive Secretary, Mr. Hj. Major (RTD) Hanif Bin Maidin and Mr. Khairunnizam Bin Mustapa, CRDD's General Manager, and other parties who were directly and indirectly involved in this programme.

The programme has also achieved its objectives. This platform has increasingly become more and more relevant and meaningful to all the members in order to reduce or minimise accidents, dangerous occurrences, occupational diseases and occupational poisoning at workplace across the Asian region. The sharing of OSH information is very crucial to all AOSHRI members in understanding the root cause of occupational safety and health issues at workplace. They could also help suggest the practical solutions based on the countries OSH framework. Hazards are borderless and blind. All AOSHRI members are urged to give response and feedback to the leader or deputy leader of each project by providing the information required, (if they are not confidential). It will help make the collaborative research project more meaningful and successful. The progress of the project will be presented during 8th AOSHRI Meeting 2020 in the Republic of Korea by leader/ deputy leader of each group.


