The report also stated that there still seems to be a lack of knowledge regarding occupational hazards and preventive culture, and to mitigate this, it has been highlighted that effective, coordinated communication and information is needed to promote compliance and lead to the adoption of sufficient OSH measures.

Hence, the key here is to improve communication regardless of whether it is top-down or bottom-up. This, as barriers to communication, might be a problem as bureaucracy rears its ugly head in almost all organisations. Aiming to reduce red tape are ways we can improve communication on OSH and its compliance. There also needs to be an open door culture to enable healthy communication not only on matters related to OSH but respective organisational values. Regular and timely communication between workers and employers also on top of providing workers with updated info and OSH guidance materials is of paramount importance.

Here at the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health Malaysia, information dissemination is and has always been one of our core functions and online webinars and seminars are conducted regularly to not only promote but nurture the hope that the public inculcates OSH practices.

Moving on, investing in OSH training for employees improves understanding and compliance with OSH regulations. However, the impact of the pandemic has its economic realities. We see businesses winding up while some struggle to stay afloat. Austerity measures will happen, but this should not be a reason to cut back extensively on OSH training for employees.

The ILO has recommended that workers' reps in training is essential as their understanding of the particular issues faced by other workers and can aid in their education of COVID-19 and promote better behavioural changes. Companies should value this proposition and find ways to not only prioritise business operations, but value and equate Occupational Safety and Health aspects to be on par with business goals.

After all, it is said and done, perhaps the key to any company or organisations success in OSH is not only the involvement but also the commitment of its people. It was earlier mentioned that the most valuable asset a company has is its people. These very same individuals form the *Keluarga Malaysia*. We are all working to a common objective of peace, harmony and prosperity, and in the middle our commitment and pledge to OSH must never be forgotten or conveniently overlooked. 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Kempen 'OSH in School' telah dijalankan sejak tahun 2002 oleh pihak NIOSH. Peringkat awal program ini disusun dengan kerjasama daripada pihak industri. Pelbagai aktiviti disusun seperti 'Hazard Hunt', '5 minutes OSH talks' dan kursus bersiri kepada guru-guru bagi sekolah yang telah dipilih oleh pihak industri sebagai sekolah angkat untuk program 'OSH in School'.

Mengapa kempen 'OSH in School' perlu diteruskan? Ini kerana, sekolah merupakan sebuah tempat kerja, yang terdiri daripada guru, kakitangan sekolah, pelajar dan pihak lain yang berurusan dengan pihak sekolah. Dari segi perundangan, sebagai sebuah tempat kerja, sekolah adalah tertakluk kepada Akta Keselamatan dan Kesihatan Pekerjaan (AKKP 1994).

Tujuan akta itu sendiri adalah untuk memastikan keselamatan, kesihatan dan kebajikan orang-orang yang sedang bekerja, untuk melindungi orang-orang di tempat kerja selain daripada orang-orang yang sedang bekerja dan mengadakan persekitaran kerja yang sesuai dengan kehendak psikologi dan fisiologi.

Di dalam kes sekolah, orang yang bekerja ialah guru, pentadbir dan kakitangan sokongan. Manakala istilah 'selain daripada orang-orang bekerja' pula merujuk kepada para pelajar dan pelawat. Sementara pengurusan sekolah dan Jabatan Pendidikan diklasifikasikan sebagai 'majikan' sekolah.

Adalah menjadi tanggungjawab pihak pengurusan sekolah untuk memastikan sekolah menjadi satu tempat yang selamat

dan sihat kepada guru, kakitangan, pelajar dan pelawat. Antara kewajipan am majikan ialah memastikan setakat yang praktikal keselamatan, kesihatan dan kebajikan pekerja mereka (seksyen 15, AKKP 1994), kewajipan membentuk dasar keselamatan dan kesihatan (seksyen 16, AKKP 1994), memastikan setakat yang praktikal pekerja dan orang-orang lain yang bukan pekerjaanya yang mungkin berada sekitar tempat kerja itu agar tidak terdedah kepada risiko keselamatan dan kesihatan (seksyen 17, AKKP 1994) dan memastikan bahawa semua cara masuk dan keluar daripada premis bagi kegunaan orang-orang yang menggunakan premis itu, dan apa-apa loji atau bahan dalam premis itu atau yang diadakan bagi kegunaan di sana adalah selamat dan tanpa risiko kepada kesihatan (seksyen 18, AKKP 1994).

Sejak beberapa tahun kebelakangan ini, kemalangan dan kecederaan yang berlaku di premis sekolah masih ada dipaparkan di dalam media. Enrolmen pelajar seluruh Malaysia juga telah mencecah lebih 5 juta orang. Manakala guru pula mencecah lebih 400 ribu orang. Bilangan yang tinggi ini sudah pasti memberi petunjuk kepada kita untuk mengambil serius bagi memastikan keselamatan dan kesihatan dilaksanakan di sekolah.

Memahami keadaan yang ada ini dan kehadiran COVID-19 yang melanda dunia serta juga dengan melihat kejayaan industri menjaga keselamatan dan kesihatan para pekerja dan pelanggan mereka, NIOSH Malaysia telah mengambil inisiatif untuk meneruskan kempen 'OSH in School' ini!

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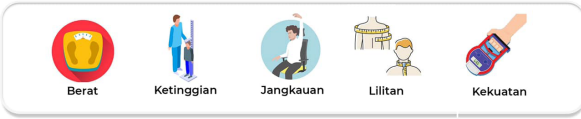

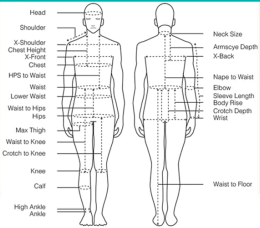


## Data Antropometrik

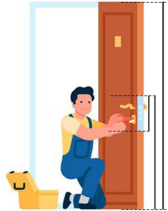

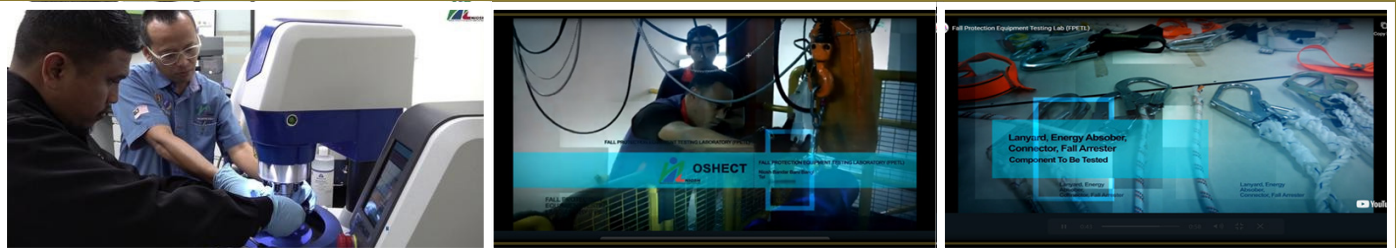
**PERKESO Financial Aid Grant**
